

Quarterly

The Responsibilities of the Venturing Forum Commissioner:

Assemble an exciting, motivational, and informative FORUM.

Recruit and train a team for **both** adult & youth volunteers.

Recruit Consultants from the community.

Serve as a member of the District Commissioner Staff.

Coordinate with the Training Team to provide supplemental training opportunities.

Spend as much time planning a FORUM as conducting one.






The Successful Venturing Forum

There is no standard program—the forum staff should do whatever works best for the participants in their particular district.

Program Feature—Based on the results of the Program Features Survey—insert a program feature module each month. (Venturing adult leaders, crew officers, consultants, and professional staff should be asked to help).

Closing—Ask crews to rotate presenting a closing.


